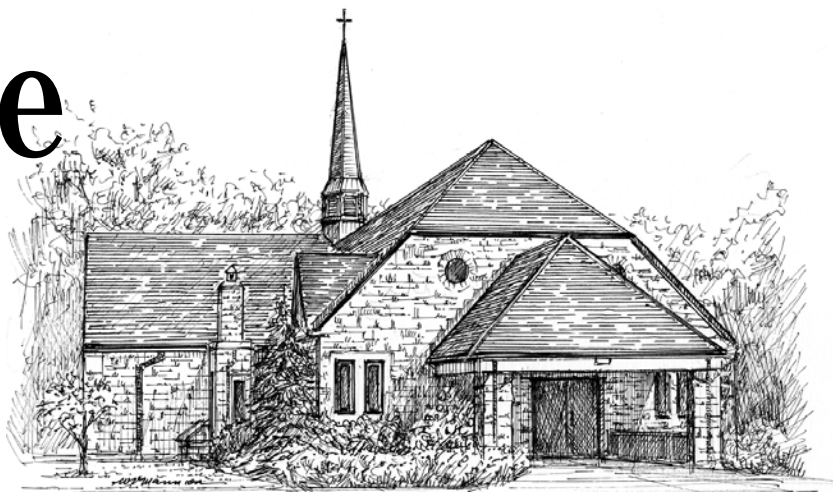

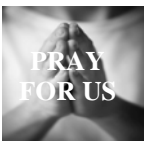
ANOINTING OF THE SICK
