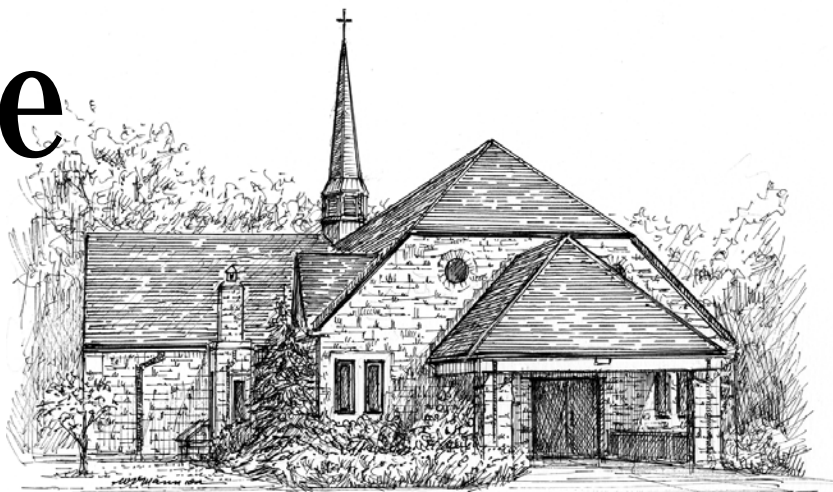

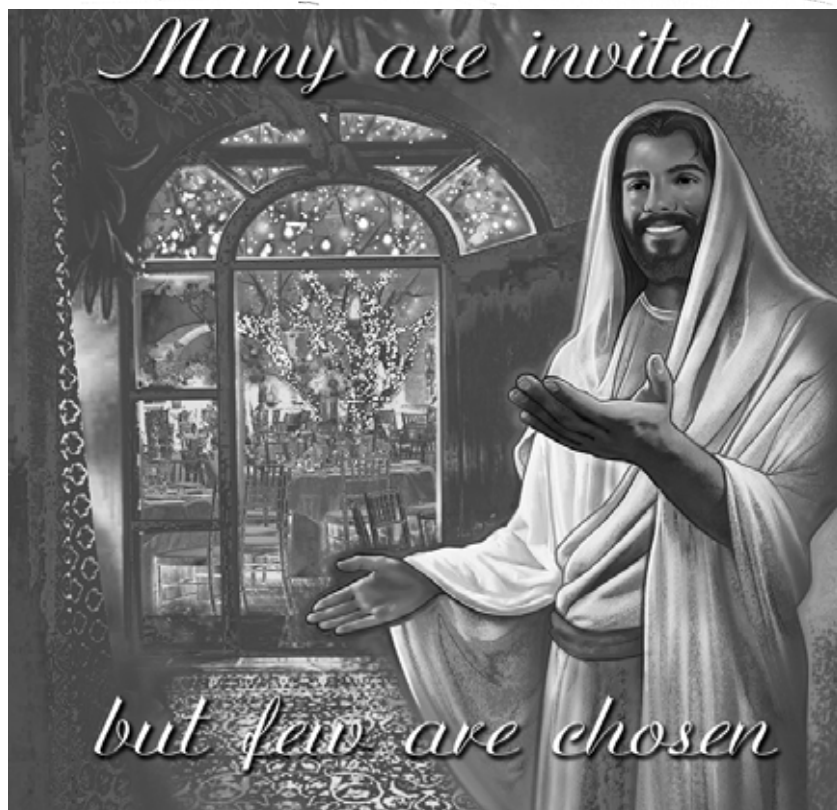

To highlight God's generosity for His people, various and powerful images are used in today's Sacred Scriptures: repeated invitations to

indifferent or violent guests, banquets with rich food and choice wines, God wiping people's tears away and destroying death forever . . .

Since many times the circumstances of our human life blind us in front of God's generosity: either we are enjoying life so well that we think to be the cause or the owner of our success, or we lead a life so miserable that we doubt God's love and generosity, Apostle Paul tells us about his own life, saying he knows how to live in humble circumstance and also how to live in abundance; in fact, Paul has the firm conviction that God is always with him, providing for him and strengthening him.

Even with God's generosity, the minimal requirement of "the wedding garment" means: our "yes" to God's generosity implies penance and conversion.

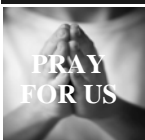
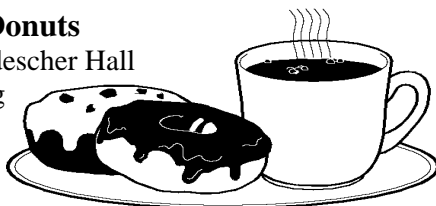
