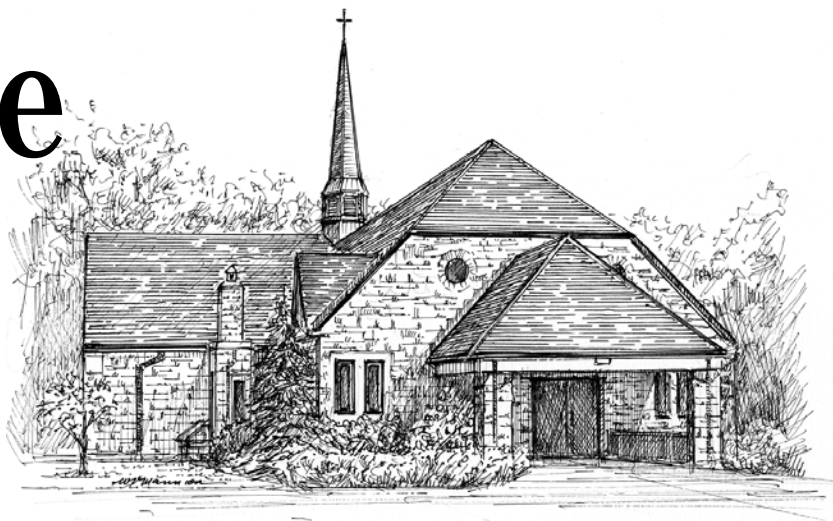

UNLIMITED FORGIVENESS

Jesus' recommendation about forgiveness will be easy to accept and to understand for the one who considers

himself as a debtor seeing in Jesus an advocate pleading his cause; but for the one who believes to be like an owner to whom people owe forgiveness, Jesus' teaching inviting for unlimited forgiveness will sound either crazy or exaggerated.

For this reason the Gospel has the example of a debtor who is at the same time an owner; he knows that he can ask and obtain forgiveness when he needs it, but when it is his turn to let a friend enjoy his forgiveness, he refuses.

The Gospel story is a reminder that each one of us is a debtor, in need of God's forgiveness all life long, living and dying for the Lord. So there is no reason for us to keep anger in our hearts when our God is all love, all peace and all reconciliation, when Jesus Christ became flesh, suffered, died and rose from the dead to let us enjoy communion with Trinity and with our brothers and sisters.

We will always be ready to forgive our brothers and sisters when we keep in mind the forgiving love of God for us.

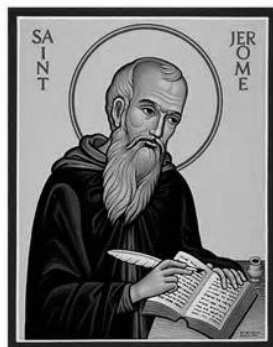

Registration forms for Wednesday night religious education can be found on-line. Classes start at 6:30 and run from now till May.

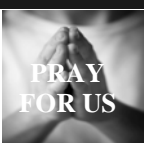
CONFIRMATION—Register now
