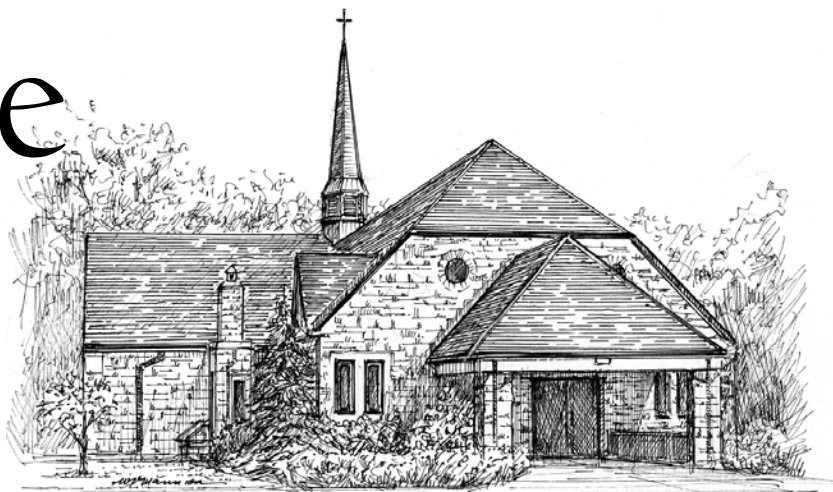

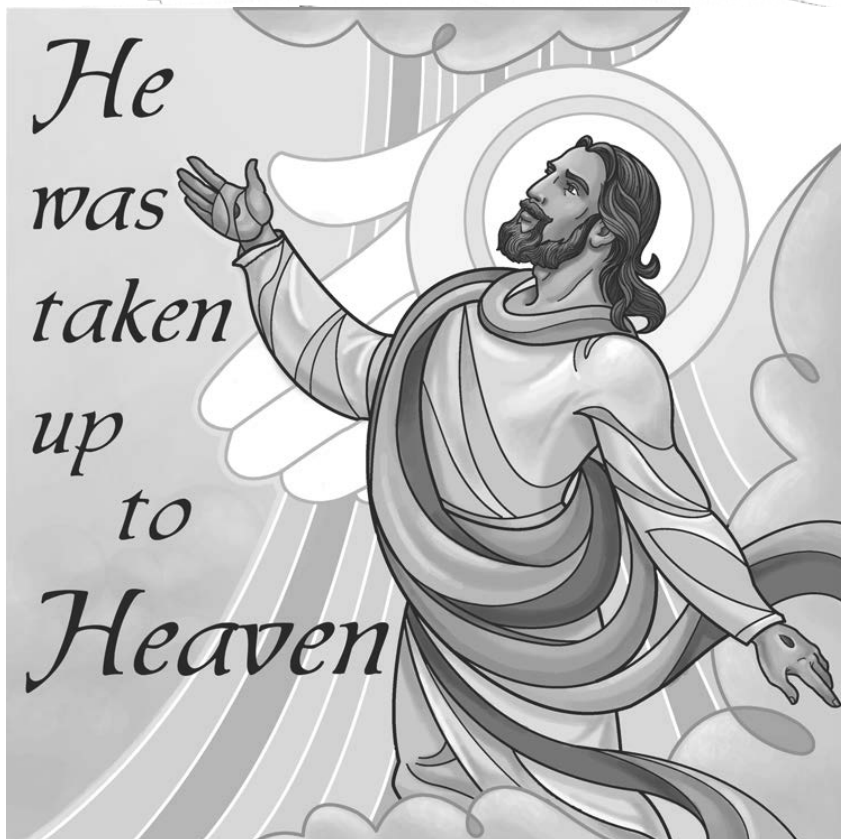

**THE ASCENSION
OF THE LORD**

The going away of Jesus Christ with His Ascension is a fact that Jesus Himself is trying to explain

and justify: "if you loved Me, you would rejoice that I am going to the Father" - "it is better for you that I go. For if I do not go, the Advocate will not come to you" - "if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you to Myself."

In the same time, Jesus is telling disciples that this going away won't be complete disappearance: "I will be with you always to the end of the earth" - "Remain in Me and I remain in you. I am the Vine and you are the branches" - "Whoever loves Me will keep my Word, and my Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our dwelling with him" - "the Holy Spirit Whom the Father will send in My name will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you."

So, even after His Ascension into Heaven, Jesus will continue to be in our midst with all His love and powers: first of all the Church is His own body and disciples are His witnesses all over the world, and with the supreme commandment of love observed and lived by disciples, the dwelling of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit will be with them. Besides all the above, we are dealing with God whose ways of being present are unlimited and unpredictable.
