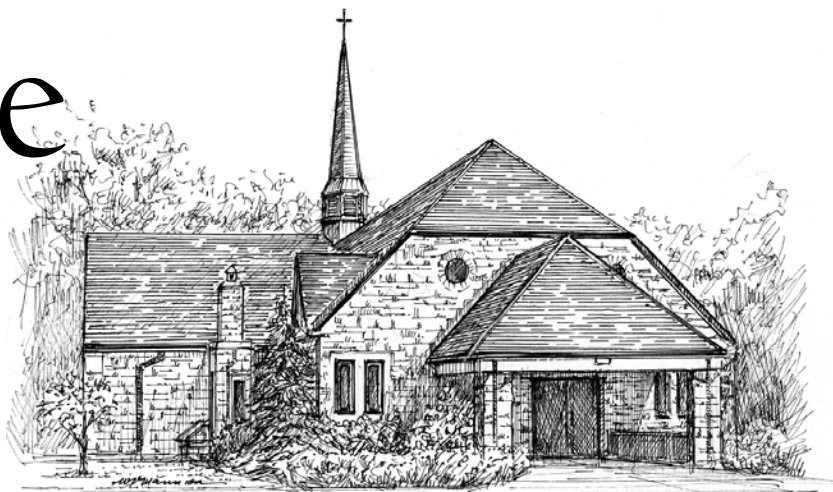

PENTECOST

On the fifth day after Easter, as promised by Jesus, the Apostles received the Holy Spirit in a very solemn way and the description of this reception in the Acts of the Apostles reveals much about the Holy Spirit besides what Jesus had already taught disciples.

Jesus calls the Holy Spirit "the Advocate", a person pleading and working on behalf of another. The Advocate will continue Jesus' mission of giving disciples what He got from the Father so that disciples would not feel orphans, so that they would be provided with special energies to go till the ends of the earth bearing witness to Jesus Christ, announcing the Good News of salvation and making the Holy Trinity present in the world.

The description mentioned above allows us to discover how powerful and how special the transformation of the Apostles at Pentecost was, even their tongues were enabled to cross barriers of tribes and cultures and reach out to the whole world. In a few years after Jesus' ascension, they had gone from Jerusalem to Rome, from Samaria to Corinth, from Judea to Athens and Antioch. . .

It is this same Spirit Who is our Advocate helping us recognize Jesus as the only Lord and supporting us in all our efforts to live as Jesus' witnesses.

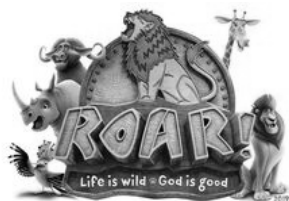

Please pray for Mike Hoffman and Ashley Pavel who will received the sacrament of marriage at St. Jerome on Saturday June 1.

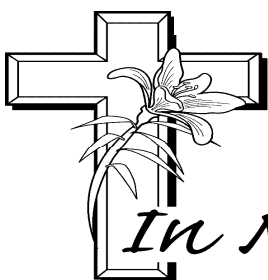

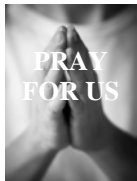
