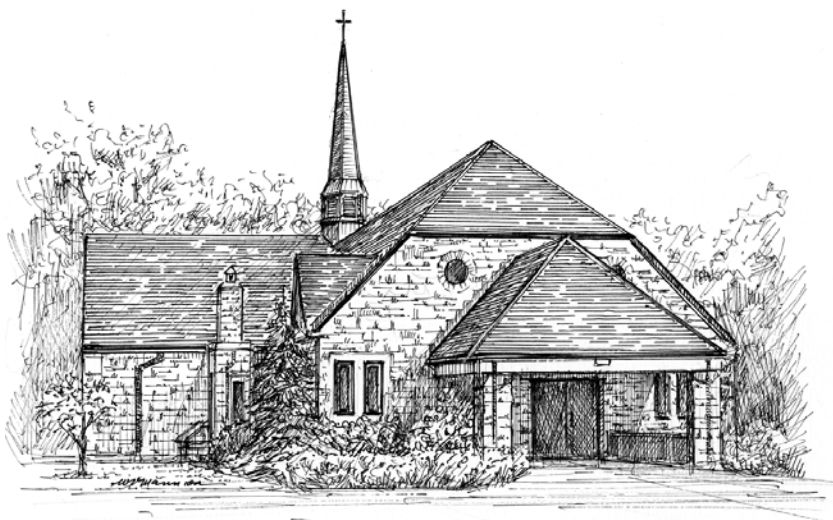

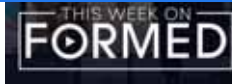
EUCHARIST ADORATION CHAPEL

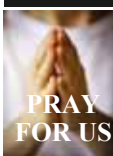
HARVEST PACK—Aug. 9
