



MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR



Dear Sisters and Brothers,

This Sunday we celebrate one of our important feasts: the feast of the Holy Spirit. We remember and celebrate Jesus giving his apostles the gift of the Holy Spirit. The clarity of the mission, the giving of the Holy Spirit and the sending off of his disciples mark


the birth of the church. Today, we can celebrate our birthday!

With this celebration we conclude our Easter story. The story of the birth of our church should invite us to remember and reflect the mission of evangelization that is our very life and essence. The abiding presence of the Holy Spirit makes us fulfill our mission as Jesus would have wanted us to do. It is the same Spirit that journeys with us so we can live our lives according to the designs of our Father in heaven.

There are two words from the original texts of the bible that will help us understand what is the Holy Spirit and its role in our life and in the life of the church. From the Septuagint, the Greek word is "pneuma hagio." Hagios means holy and pneuma means breath or spirit or wind. In Hebrew, ruach is the word for spirit or breath. During the Last Supper Jesus told the disciples "I'm going to go away and then I am going to come back again and then I'm going to give you the gift of the Spirit." (John 15). He said that the spirit is going to lead us to all truth. The Spirit is our advocate and our guide.

The Holy Spirit is the third person in the Trinitarian identity of our God. The Spirit is God. His presence in us continues to this day in the Holy Spirit. We are a church that is constantly guided by God himself.
