

Click on *join an existing program*. Enter enrollment code **B89AB59714377**. Click on *enroll*. Type in your first and last name only and then the *next* button. Add your email address and create a password. Pick your 2 security questions and fill in the answers. Set up your recovery phone (mobile phone number). Pick your contact method by either selecting text or phone call and you will receive a 6 digit code to enter. Click on *get started*. Follow the prompts.
