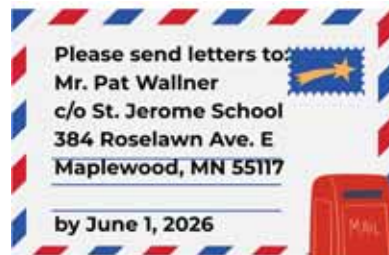
PRINCIPAL's CORNER—Mrs. Gattman

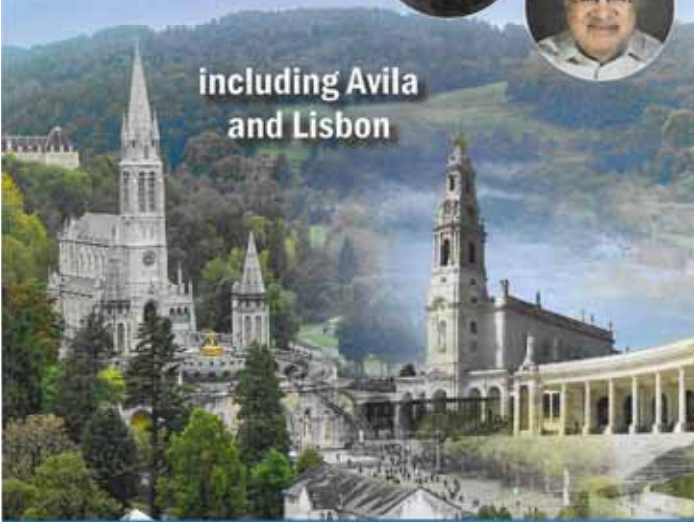
