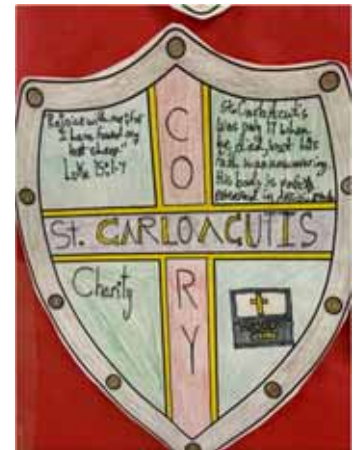

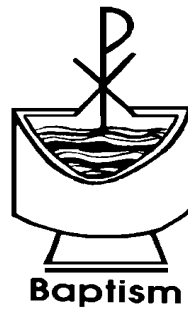

If you would rather reload than wait for the next physical sale, it is very easy to do. You would set up an online account by going to raiserright.com on your browser. Click on *join an existing program*. Enter enrollment code **B89AB59714377**. Click on *enroll*. Type in your first and last name only and then the *next* button. Add your email address and create a password. Pick your 2 security questions and fill in the answers. Set up your recovery phone (mobile phone number). Pick your contact method by either selecting text or phone call and you will receive a 6 digit code to enter. Click on *get started*. Follow the prompts. If you have any trouble at all setting up you account, please email me at auglie@usfamily.net.

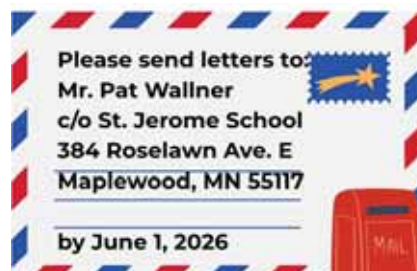
CATHOLIC WATCHMEN—May 19
